Our Community Center Building is coming to life. All the ground work is completed, the footings and foundation are in, and the steel is starting to be erected. If you go by the site you can see all the work that has been completed to date. The project is on schedule and we should all be planning some great uses for the new complex. It will be a great asset to the community.

The construction on each end of Locust Street is MUD installing new vaults, meters and valves on our water distribution system. This is a planned improvement and just part of our infrastructure improvement project. Trying to update parts to our old system, thus, this should be completed this month. Thanks for all your cooperation!

Our sewer relining project is about 50% completed. The plan is to work thru the winter and keep the project going while we have a low water table. This makes the process much easier without the challenges involved with a of a high water table in the Spring. Keep in mind, once this upgrade is completed, It should stop infiltration of ground water and prolong the life of our pumps and system.

This time of year is very busy at City Hall. Our yearly budget process is: The City Council meets with department heads to go over all the operating expenses and needed improvements for each department. This involves a challenging process to implement all city services and programs while also improving and maintaining all city owned assets.
