

- 1. Current picture identification for Carter Lake -Driver's license or ID
- 2. Social Security Cards for everyone in the household
- 3. Proof of household income for the last 30 days
- 4. Current utility bill, with Carter Lake address, in your name within the last 30 days
- 5. Birth certificates for all children

Failure to have all the listed information attached will disqualify your application.

Applicants must also be willing to sign a release form allowing the Police Department or News media to use images of the children taken during the event for publication.
