Hello Again,

We are very close to opening the new Community Center, once a few interior finishes are completed. Outside, the irrigation system, the sod and the plantings will be in place next week. Sandy and her crew are working diligently, putting everything in place for the doors to open. The Community Center will be ready for your enjoyment. Stay tuned for the planned Grand Opening.

The Prairie Flower Casino has committed to the Phase Two Project. This is great news for our community. It will increase the building by 60,000 sq. ft.. This will add a sports bar, a restaurant and increased gaming, therefore, offering 200 more jobs. This should create a desired, new destination which our town needs to attract other types of food and entertainment, thereby, aligning with the surrounding areas.

Our six hotels offer over 400 rooms nightly, utilized mostly by airport and downtown users. They spend money on entertainment and food. If you factor in all the surrounding development, we are in a perfect location to take advantage of the entertainment/tourist market. Currently, we are working with a development that should help capture and direct these users to our community, which means more jobs and tax dollars for Carter Lake.

I want to thank all of our volunteers that help this community. Without the volunteers, our town would not be in the great shape it is currently.

SNOW IS COMING...

Sadly to say, winter is coming soon. Please remember that all sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 24-hours after the snow stops. If you do not remove your snow and ice, the City may remove it and charge you per foot for removal plus a \$75 administrative fee. Please keep your sidewalks clear of snow and ice.

If a snow emergency is declared by the Mayor, the dates and times of the emergency will be broadcast on local radio and television stations. If there is more than 4" of snow and the mayor declares a snow emergency, there shall be no parking on the streets, avenues or alleys until the street is cleared.

Here is an update to get you excited about the CLCC! First, we have a new employee! Dan Adams started last week as the Recreation & Fitness Manager for the Center. He is currently located in City Hall with me until we can move into the community center.

We have also finalized Les Mills Virtual which will offer virtual group fitness classes for youth and adults (Mom and Dad you could do some of these classes as a family too). Options will be available on a regular schedule but also as an “on-demand” option. This gives you an option of picking the time and workout you want to do if the room is empty. (Offered during regular business hours). The fitness room with all the equipment will have some extended hours to allow you to work out when you are available. We are also working on some fitness classes for older adults and social activities such as BingoCize®, and Chair Volleyball. Walking & Pickleball Clubs, pick-up sports for adults along with Dodgeball and other active games for youth. All these activities and more will be included in the membership! Larger social events are in the works as well, such as a Super Bowl Party with more to come.

The current library entrance will eventually be closed when the Community Center is completed, and one entry will access both the center and library. The CLCC will be working with the library staff in offering different activities for the whole family. The existing Senior Center will remain open and fully operational until we open the CLCC to members and the community.


