# **Carter Lake Newsletter**

The City Council adopted a resolution to study and start a water system improvement plan, at the last Council meeting. This includes updating some water mains and the water valves that are currently not working. The new valves will allow us to isolate area's that may need maintained or repaired. At this time, many of the valves are past the date recommended to be replaced. This study will assist the City applying for grants and other funding. This would lessen the burden on the City and the tax payer. We have already identified and secured some possible funding sources for this project. I will keep you informed when the work will begin.

The City Council made a motion at last meeting to upgrade the old wooden playset at Mabrey Park. This project will include a concrete base with a padded mat on top, including, a complete new playset. The work will only be done in the play area. The rest of the park will remain open during this project.

The Community Center will have a soft opening on Sunday, January, 22, from noon to 3:00. This will allow you to walk thru and see what the building has to offer. On Monday, January, 23, the center is open for your enjoyment. Stop in and take a tour with Sandy. This project has taken a ton of effort and planning. Keeping the commitment, the Carter Lake Community Center has something for everyone.

Remember, all City meetings are open to the public. In January, we will be starting the budget process. This is a plan for the next year's City business. We meet with all department heads to find out their needs, look at past department costs and future improvements. It is a long and laborious process to improve and upgrade City services, while maintaining a low tax levy. This process takes a lot of difficult decisions. # **NEW YEARS EVE FIREWORKS**

January 1st from 12:00 a.m. - 12:30 a.m.

### Penalty:

Any discharging of consumer fireworks outside of the excepted dates, hours, or locations, or under conditions restricted shall be deemed a simple misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00. Restrictions:

- Class 1 and Class 2 may NOT be discharged by anyone under the age of 18
- Novelties may be discharged by anyone 5 or older but only when supervised by an adult.
- Individuals may only light fireworks on their own property or property where they have the consent of the owner.
- No fireworks are permitted to be charged on areas zoned C-3/Commercial or C4/Commercial.
- No individual shall discharge fireworks within 30 feet of another person or within 30 feet of a structure.
- No person shall discharge consumer fireworks at any time when Pottawattamie County has issued a burn ban.
- Fireworks are not permitted on public property which includes the right-of-way (i.e. street, sidewalks, parks)
