Hello,

I am sure you have noticed some construction at the intersection of Abbott and Locust in recent days. The City of Omaha's River Front trail system project is underway. Starting in downtown Omaha heading north along the west side of Abbott Drive, crossing the railroad tracks in front of the hotels and connecting to the existing trail at Kiwanis Park along Locust Street. This trail will include two bus stops along the way and feature great landscaping crossing at Gallup dr. (at stop lights connecting to the Millers Landing recreation and public property). This phase ties the Carter Lake trail system into Omaha's and is a great addition to our community and this joint project through both cities along the Abbott Drive corridor. The project will be completed this year. Carter Lake Trail project will be constructed during the summer of 2024.

Our water system project is moving right along. The Maintenance Supervisor, the City Clerk and I met with the engineering firm for further planning. This project is on course to have the bid specs and plans completed this year and the project go out for bid in February/March 2024 with work completed by the fall of 2024. This project will allow for the replacement of valves, and other improvements that will help ensure many more years of service for the water system.

The City wide sewer system improvements that were completed last year are showing a very positive impact and that investment in this asset will help us for many years to come thanks for everyone's patients through this project.

Recently Carter Lake lost four time Mayor Jerry Waltrip, a lifelong resident, friend and huge supporter of our town. His dedication to this community for over a 50 year span has helped us get to where we are today. Jerry always put Carter Lake first and would fight for what was right. He will be missed. Thank You Mayor Waltrip.

RENTAL HOUSING INSPECTION PROGRAM

Did you know that cities within Iowa with a population of 15,000 or more are mandated by the State of Iowa to have a rental housing inspection program.

In 2018, the Carter Lake City Council agreed it was in the best interest of renters to develop a Rental Inspection program and the city has established an ordinance for rental housing inspections in order to establish minimum quality standards for all residential dwellings; to provide for the enforcement of such standards; to establish a program of regular rental inspections; and to protect the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Carter Lake, Iowa.

The rental housing inspectors perform random and complaint-based inspections looking for dangerous conditions and violations of compliance with minimum physical standards for residences. There are 175+ units registered with the city. Inspectors normally will perform 12 inspections per month.

All owners of rental property are **required** to register each rental unit with the City. There is ZERO cost for registration. Inspections are free unless a third re-inspection is ordered for landlords failure of 1st and 2nd inspections.


