The Riverfront Trail System Project along Abbot is running on schedule and the crews are doing an excellent job. The new part of the trail is a huge asset to our community. The trail system will connect us to the Omaha trail system. This project has been a long time in the planning. Please get out and enjoy the new part of the Trail System when you have time.

The City of Omaha will be replacing an existing sewer force main line from the east Omaha lift station to the 11th street lift station. The new alignment will be along Avenue H through Carter Lake. The city of Omaha will begin construction on November 27. This sewer project will last approximately one year. This new forced main will connect Omaha's lift station to the Carter Lake 9th street lift station. It will increase the reliability of our sewer service and Carter Lake's sanitary sewer service will not be affected during the construction.

Our Carter Lake Boy's and Girl's club's new building is coming to life. Recently, at the beam signing ceremony, I visited with the leadership of the club, and they are extremely excited about the future and what this building will bring to the program. The Boys and Girls Club is a great community partner and a huge bonus for our city.

Phase two of the Prairie Flower Casino Project is in progress and is expected to be completed in 18 months. Therefore, please take caution when travelling on Avenue H over the next few months. These two projects are happening at the same time; Thereby, it becomes a remarkably busy street. Lane and parking restrictions will be necessary during the construction period.





Dear Resident/Business/Property Owner:

The City of Omaha will replace an existing sewer force main line from the East Omaha Lift Station to 11th Street with a new line. The new alignment will be along Avenue H in Carter Lake, lowa, and 11th and 15th Streets in Omaha. Construction is scheduled to begin November 27 and proceed through December 31, 2024. Here's what to expect during the project.

Who? The City of Omaha selected JEO Consulting Group to provide construction administration for this project. Valley Corporation will be handling the construction work.

What? The sanitary sewer force main serving East Omaha and Carter Lake will be replaced to increase reliability of service to the area. The existing sewer line will be abandoned. Your sanitary sewer service will not be affected during construction.

When? Construction is scheduled to begin November 27, 2023, and last through December 31, 2024.

Where? The new force main will connect the City's East Omaha Lift Station on 15th Street, run along Avenue H and tie into the North Interceptor Sewer on 11th Street. The Carter Lake Lift Station on 9th Street will also be connected to this new sewer force main. Construction will start on 11th Street and move east in phases along Avenue H, through Carter Lake, and end at 15th Street. The project will include 7 phases and you will receive prior notice about specific plans before the start of each phase.

Will there be access restrictions? Lane restrictions, street closings, and parking restrictions will be necessary during construction. During road closures, alternate routes will be assigned, and local access maintained with restrictions to driveways at select locations. Property owners with restricted driveway access will be notified prior to any restrictions.

La ciudad de Omaha sustituirá una línea principal de alcantarillado a presión existente desde la estación de bombeo de aguas residuales del este de Omaha (*East Omaha Lift Station*) hasta la calle 11t por una nueva línea. El nuevo trazado se ubicará a lo largo de la avenida H de Carter Lake, Iowa, y las calles 11 y 15 de Omaha. La construcción está programada para comenzar el 27 de noviembre y continuará hasta el 31 de diciembre del 2024. Esto es lo que puede esperar durante el transcurso del proyecto.

La construcción comenzará en la calle 11 y se moverá hacia el este en fases a lo largo de la Avenida H, a través de Carter Lake, y terminará en la calle 15. El proyecto incluirá 7 fases y usted recibirá un aviso previo sobre los planes específicos antes del comienzo de cada fase.

¿Habrá restricciones de acceso? Serán necesarias las restricciones de carriles, cierres de calles y restricciones de estacionamiento durante la construcción. Durante los cierres de carreteras, se asignarán rutas alternativas y se mantendrá el acceso local con restricciones a las entradas de vehículos en determinados lugares. 
