This was all made possible by our team in the Maintenance Department, putting in a nonstop effort to keep the town running. Now the follow up services and putting the town back to where we were prior to the storm has been a huge task. I want to recognize our team leader Bob and his staff, Randy, Ronnie Ethen, Trey, and Charlie who all went above and beyond during this storm event. The Lakeside development on Locust Street is in full swing. This new building helps change the look to the Locust Street corridor from 9th to 13th. The city-wide water distribution project is underway. Our contractor has agreed to work hard to keep water service disruptions and lane restrictions to a minimum throughout this large project. We are replacing aging valves and hydrants. When the planned shutdown is scheduled, every home affected will receive a hanging door notice of water shut off. The work being completed is a much-needed update to help prolong the life of our water infrastructure. Thank you for your cooperation and patience during this project.

The City Council has hired Tyler Heinsheid as our new Community Center Director. Tyler comes with a wealth of knowledge and experience in management that we need to continue to operate the Community Center.

Hello Carter Lake Residents,

My name is Tyler Henscheid. I am the new Director at the Carter Lake Community Center. I grew up a short distance away in Shelby County, Iowa, and I graduated from Harlan Community High school before earning a degree in Recreation Administration from San Diego State University.

In addition to serving in Marine Corp Reserves, the bulk of my 17 years in the recreation field, has been supporting the military community. I started my career teaching, coaching, and helping provide a positive space at an afterschool program for middle school children. Shortly after, I started working for the Navy and managed a recreation center which annually served 127,000 sailors ages 18-25. This facility was intended to keep young men and women involved

in positive leisure activities during their down time and offered computers, games, a library, movie theater, table games and more. It also included many events and trips for sailors to explore all the geographical and cultural sites and scenes of Southern California.

I then had the opportunity to directly support military personnel by going aboard 75 surface ships, 3 aircraft carriers, 6 fast attack submarines, and other vessels in port to provide recreation and fitness equipment to use while the ships were out at sea. I also taught classes on recreation planning and audited the finances of the surface fleet located in San Diego.

I knew I wanted to get back to the Midwest to raise my growing family. I was offered the position of Community Programs Director at Offutt Air Force Base. This position included directing a community center with diverse venues. This involved planning and executing over 100 morale and special event programs annually. I also managed food and beverage operations to support the facility.

At home my family includes my wonderful wife, Jenni, and four amazing young kids ages ten, eight, six, and three years old. As a family, we enjoy being outdoors, going on scenic drives, and exploring new places around Iowa.

My goal in this position is to enrich the lives of all residents of Carter Lake, Iowa, by maximizing the new community center venue space and providing recreational opportunities for the community. I am eager to get acquainted with community members and would love to hear any ideas, interests, or activities you would like to see offered. Finally, I appreciate the opportunity to serve the community and look forward to meeting you all soon.

2024 Water Valve Project

This past year, City representatives have been working with engineers to develop a plan of action to make improvements to the water infrastructure within our community.

During the next three months the City's contractor Backlund Plumbing, plans to complete multi-location replacements during 4-8 hour shut-downs; it is expected there will be 2-3 crews working in multiple locations during a single planned shut-down.

Notifications will be accomplished with hanging door tags several days in advance of the planned shut-downs. If a city wide notification is required, these will be posted via Facebook, the city website and sent via email notifications.



We anticipate that these notices will allow residents plenty of time to make arrangements.

If you receive a notice, it is recommended to fill the bathtub or buckets to continue flushing toilets, and pitchers of water or bottled water for drinking during the shutdowns.

As always during any pressure loss situation, protection of public health and safety are the priority and primary concern. The actual duration of the shut-off will depend on the conditions encountered. Once the work has been performed, your water service will be restored.

Please note that the water may be discolored after the water service is restored but should clear up in a short period of time. If it does not clear up, please call City Hall at (712) 347-6320.

Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

Did you know that residents could be issued a notice of abatement and penalties for refusing to clean up a property nuisance?

Residents can maintain compliance by cleaning up and or removing the following items:

- *Weed and grass taller than 9inches
- *Unlicensed vehicles
- *Buildings in general disrepair
- *Weeds and volunteer trees in the fence
- *Junk, trash debris, and piles
- *Vacant homes
- *Tires
- *Construction materials

RESIDENTIAL CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP

Trucks will make one pass through town, Please have all acceptable waste on the curb by 6 a.m. Saturday, September 21st, and leave it on the curb until it has been picked up.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- **Construction - Demolition materials** (bricks, stones, concrete, concrete block or rubble, shingles, lumber, landscape timbers, siding, and drywall).
- **Liquids** (motor oil, antifreeze, paint, and household chemicals). Some service stations accept motor oil for recycling.
- **Hazardous materials** (flammables, propane tanks, auto parts, explosives). Auto parts should be taken to an auto salvage yard. Propane Tanks and Hazardous Materials may be dropped off to the Recycling Center, 4441 Gifford Road, C.B.
- **E-Waste (electronics)**. Recycle items at the Recycling Center at 4441 Gifford Road, Council Bluffs. Electronics including cell phones, computers and monitors, copiers, DVD players, game systems, laptops, printers, tablets, televisions, etc. can be recycled at the Recycling Center for just **\$0.35/lb**

ITEMS ACCEPTED

*non inclusive

- Trees, shrubbery, carpet, fencing, poles, iron, etc. must be cut in 4' lengths, bundled, and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds per bundle;
- Yard and Garden waste
- **White Goods (Appliances) MUST** be empty with doors removed; water heater, stove dehumidifier, freezer, air conditioner, TV.
- Furniture, household items, trash
- Empty paint cans will **ONLY** be accepted if the drivers can see that the paint is dried or absorbed with a substance like cat litter or saw dust.

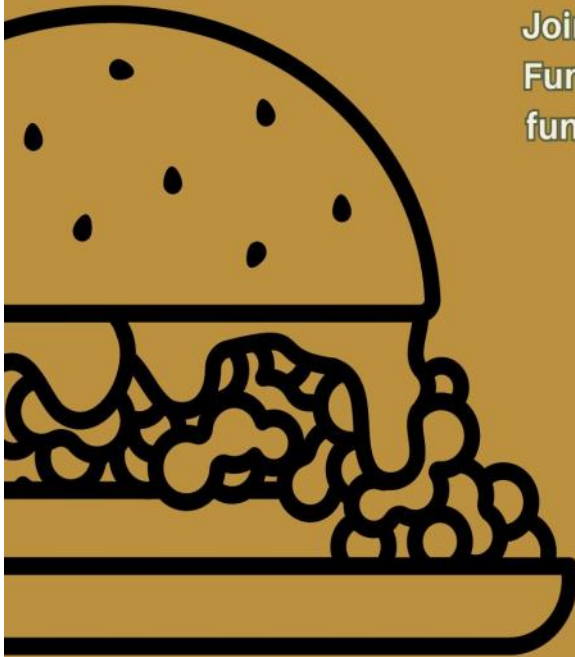
