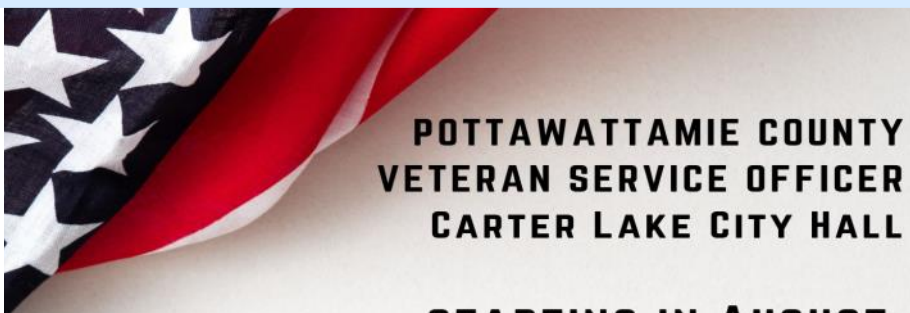

## 2024 Water Valve Project

We have entered the final stage of this water valve replacement project for 2024. Notifications will continue to be accomplished with hanging door tags several days in advance of the planned shut-downs to a small area of the community. City wide notification will be posted via Facebook, and sent via email notifications.

***After several discussions, the contractor would like to make plans for additional overnight shutdowns. Therefore, to prevent any confusion we will continue with OVERNIGHT SHUT DOWNS ON TUESDAY NIGHTS through the end of OCTOBER.***

***Will the contractor need the next three Tuesday nights? Most likely no, but we are asking residents to be aware and prepared for shut downs from 10 PM to 6 AM on***

***TUESDAYS: OCT. 15 OCT. 22 OCT. 29***

We anticipate that the advance notices will allow residents plenty of time to make arrangements. If you receive a notice, it is recommended to fill the bathtub or buckets to continue flushing toilets, and pitchers of water or bottled water for drinking during the shutdowns.

As always during any pressure loss situation, protection of public health and safety are the priority and primary concern. The actual duration of the shut-off will depend on the conditions encountered. Once the work has been performed, your water service will be restored.

Please note that the water may be discolored after the water service is restored but should clear up in a short period of time. If it does not clear up, please call City Hall at (712) 347-6320.

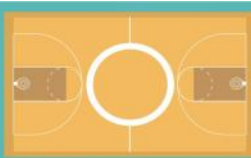
