

# Carter Lake Newsletter

Happy New Year Carter Lake Residents!

Here at City Hall, all personnel continue to work diligently to keep the community moving forward. By upgrading and supporting all the underground infrastructure over the last three years, the city has reinvested heavily into the sanitary sewer system. This included the city-wide main relining, the rebuilding of the manholes and the replacement of lift station pumps, ensuring many more years of reliable service to our community. We just completed the first phase of a water distribution project which included replacing aging valves and hydrants along with adding new pits and main water meters along Locust Street. There were much needed project to control and isolate areas when future service will be necessary.

One of my main priorities and goals is public safety. Many of you do not know how busy our first responders are. Your Fire and EMT service handles more than 400 calls for service per year. Including the time spent on training and meetings that put a lot into our volunteers. We are fortunate to have this talented group of volunteers. Next, your Police Department makes five thousand contacts a year, with a crew of ten officers. They cover the town 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Our officers are required to train and educate themselves to keep up with continued changes in equipment and the required techniques needed to keep citizens safe.

Prairie Flower Casino is continuing with the expansion of the casino. They remain a great community partner, helping Carter Lake turn into a downtown entertainment destination. Along with our hotels, this adds revenue into our city budget and allows us to do more for our community. With this expansion, they will be adding many new jobs over the next few months. This is a fantastic opportunity for some to work locally.

The city is entertaining the option of renting out the concession stands at the ball fields for the upcoming season. If you are interested, please contact City Hall.

This year brings many new opportunities to our community. We are currently collaborating with a developer on a unique project which offers an outdoor retreat with different jogging options. This is typically not available in our area. It sits on a four acre lot with lake access and will offer many different recreational activities for their customers. This project is just one of the many to come with a great fit to the downtown entertainment district. Including the Prairie Flower Casino expansion that will open soon and includes a sports bar and expanded gaming, tach on the lake, golf course and our many hotels, Carter Lake is on the way to more entertainment options which will attract other projects and developments. This will create jobs and increase our tax revenue and opportunities for everyone in Carter Lake.






