The city’s infrastructure projects are close to being complete. The planned street improvements are completed. We will be finishing with the water system upgrades over the next 45 days. There should be no more city-wide water shutdowns this season. However, there may be isolated areas that will need to be shut down. If you’re in that area, you should receive a door tag explaining the time, date and affected homes requiring water shut off. Thank you for your patience during this

project, it was a much-needed upgrade and will help greatly when maintenance is needed in the future.
